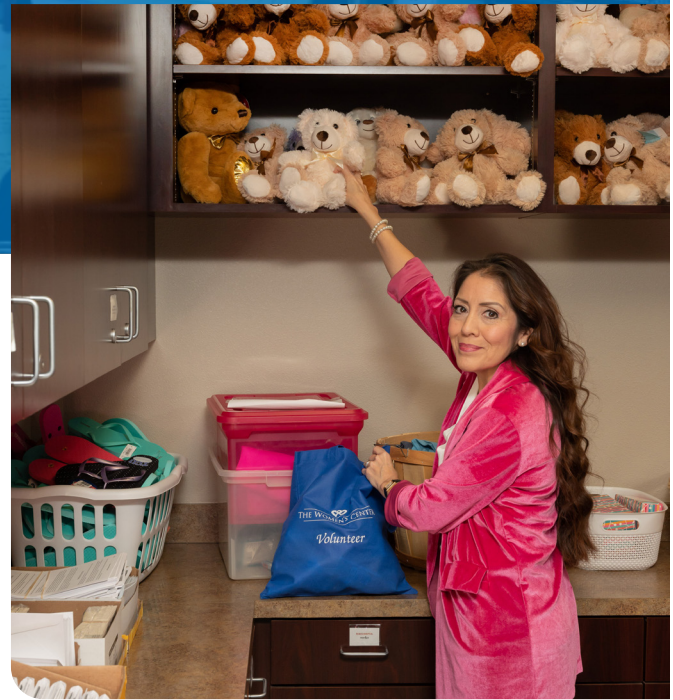

VICTIM ADVOCATE

Provide crisis intervention and emotional support to sexual assault survivors (adults and adolescents) and their significant others at local hospitals and on the 24-hour Sexual Assault Crisis Hotline. Must have own transportation.

Six hour, on-call shifts available 7 days a week

- Three shifts per month required
- One year volunteer commitment
- 40 hours training - In-person & virtual

Victim Advocate Training

In person: Tuesday, September 30 from 6-9 pm;

Saturday, October 18 from 8:30 am-4:30 pm

Virtual/Self-paced: October 1 - October 17

EMPLOYMENT ADVISOR

Assist participants with their job search by conducting mock interviews, resume reviews, and facilitating specialty seminars - in person and via Zoom. Bilingual skills (English/Spanish) preferred but not required.

- Weekly 2-3 hours shifts
- Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 4:30 pm (Some evening sessions may be needed)
- One year volunteer commitment
- 3.5 hours of training-virtually & in-person
- Attend quarterly in-service trainings throughout the year

DEPARTMENT SUPPORT VOLUNTEER

Support the staff of the Employment Solutions department in-person with general office tasks such as: filing, copying, file set up, donation organization/processing, data entry and webinar support.

- Weekly 2-3 hours shifts
- Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm
- One year volunteer commitment
- One 1.5 hour database training
- On-the-job training as needed for projects
- Attend quarterly in-service trainings throughout the year

HELPLINE VOLUNTEER

During the weekday, answer The Women's Center Helpline to provide emotional support and problem - solving assistance to people in difficult and sometimes crisis situations. Offer information about The Women's Center's services along with referrals to community resources.

- Weekly 2-3 hours shifts
- Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm
- One year volunteer commitment
- Two 4-hour training sessions
